

This checklist is compiled to help you stay organized during your move into your new home!

UTILITIES

Telephone, water, gas, electricity, trash collection, oil delivery, and security alarm monitoring. A couple of weeks before your move you should schedule to end service at your current home and start service for your new one. Here's a list of the phone numbers you'll need.

INSURANCE

Contact your insurance agent to switch or end your policies. Termination date for the policy should be about 7 days after settlement.

MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION

Make sure your drivers license and car are licensed within the required time frame. And don't forget to get a parking permit!

NEWSPAPER

Stop or transfer to your new address

CREDIT CARDS AND OTHER BILLS

Call and update your address, they will fine you so it's best to notify ahead of time to avoid additional late fees.

RENOVATIONS

Schedule all repairs, renovations and painting to be completed before your move-in date.

CLEANING

Sellers are only obligated to leave the property "broom clean" and "free of debris" so prepare to do some housekeeping before moving your belongings in or hire a professional cleaner.
